How to reach Aizawl:

Mizoram is a part of North-East India surrounded by the mighty Himalayas, the plains of Bangladesh and hills of Myanmar. Aizawl can be reached by Air through Kolkata/Guwahati. Connected flights are also available from Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Hyderabad. The Advanced Research Centre for Bamboo and Rattan (ARCBR) is approximately 35 km away from Lengpui Airport towards Aizawl city. Silchar is the nearest railway station which is 175 km away from Aizawl. The journey (by road) from Silchar to Aizawl takes around 6-8 hrs. Climate is pleasant during March. It is slightly cold and temperature remains between 18° C to 25° C.

Accommodation:

Accommodation is available in the Farmer's Hostel, ARCBR, Aizawl which can be arranged for research scholars or craftsmen on first come first served basis. 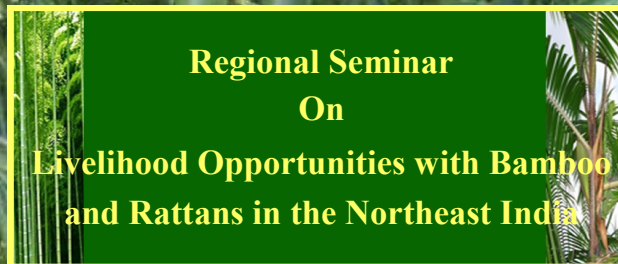

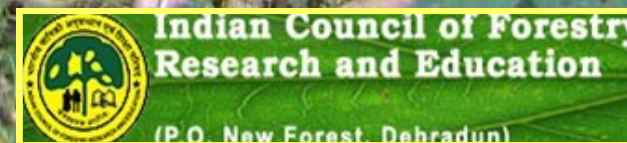
