
Please find enclosed a list of the IFS officers nominated by the Ministry of Environment Forest, Climate Change (MoEF&CC), for participation in **two-day Training Workshop on "Finance opportunities towards establishing Climate Change Resilient Forest"** to be organized by your institute/organization on **October 12-13, 2017**. The following points may kindly be kept in view for successful conduct of the training workshop.

- i On receipt of list of nominations from the MoEF&CC, the institute should request the PCCFs of the States/Head of Organisation concerned to forward the latest addresses of the nominated officers. The Course Coordinator may find out telephone numbers of officer concerned from our website www.ifs.nic.in (IFS Civil List - 2016) or www.ifs.nic.in - Research & Training Tab - In Service Training - Contact list of IFS officers.
- ii The officers nominated may kindly be intimated well in advance directly or through the PCCF concerned about the venue of the training workshop, how to reach the place, transport facilities to be provided by the institute, arrangements for their accommodation and the detailed schedule of the training workshop.
- iii The workshop may please be organized in a business-like manner avoiding prolonged inaugural and valedictory sessions.
- iv The quality reference/study material to be provided to the participants must have maximum available information at the national as well as global levels on the topic/theme of the training workshop including details of all connected/related websites.
- v The training workshop may have 2-3 technical sessions, where papers can be presented by the resource persons/participants and at least 3-4 brainstorming sessions facilitated by eminent resource persons on the sub-topics of the subject for eliciting suggestions/recommendations which may be useful for making improvements in strengthening capacities of the State Forest Departments for managing these natural resources for better service delivery to all the stakeholders efficiently. One session may be devoted for synthesizing the suggestions/recommendations.
- vi The boarding and lodging facilities to be provided to the officers nominated should be adequate to the tune of the expenses being reimbursed by the MoEF&CC.
- vii The feedback received from the participants should be forwarded to the MoEF&CC in original.

- viii **The feedback documents along with summary of recommendations (2/3 pages) should be forwarded to the ministry within a week of conduct of the workshop. (To DIG (RT), MoEF&CC)**
The detailed proceedings of the workshop may be forwarded to the MoEF&CC in the form of a bound volume within one month of completion of the training workshop.
- ix While forwarding the lists of the participants, please *mention officer's code along with cadre and year of allotment*. Kindly obtain their latest e-mail addresses and also send to the MoEF&CC along with the above details. Govt will reimburse the boarding & lodging expenses of the nominated participants for the duration of course plus one (only) more day, if the participants happen to arrive at the venue of the course on the previous day and depart on the day after completion of the course.
- x The pre-receipted bills (in quadruplicate) for reimbursement of charges may be forwarded along with the list of the officers who participated in the training workshop. **The balance amount will be released after receipt of the duly audited accounts.**
- xi For further detailed information, kindly visit our website (<http://www.ifs.nic.in>) and contact us for clarifications, if any.
- xii It has been observed from the past experience that about 50%-60% of nominated persons attend the workshop. The attendance is however more at Bangalore, Coa, Jodhpur, Peechi, Agartala. The Course Coordinator therefore should contact the participants to know whether they are attending the workshop and plan accommodation accordingly.
