

Guidelines for Dissemination of Research Related Information:

1. Project Completion Reports (PCRs) will be available in public domain through Database of research projects undertaken in ICFRE since 1990.
2. ICFRE institutes need to put all topical information in public domain. Information should be well structured giving brief introduction, state of research contributions of ICFRE institutes on the topics and further future strategy on the topics. These topics for example, may be Khejri Mortality, Shisham Mortality, Shifting Cultivation, Desert Rehabilitation, Propagation of species, genetic improvement of species, forest soil characterization, carbon sequestration, etc. Institute should try to cover all important topics on which research related information is available as institutional memory.
3. Package of practices or technology developed in ICFRE Institutes in various disciplines of forestry research needs to be in public domain through its websites. Institutes should develop on interactive web enabled forum for forestry research extension to meet the queries of the stakeholders.
4. All publications of ICFRE institutes should also be in the public domain of institutes' website.
5. All the research outcomes in the form of research papers published in National and International journal, papers presented in workshop/ seminars / research report and technical reports belonging to ICFRE scientists / Research Officers should be brought in public domain for the benefit of stakeholders. This will bring due recognition to ICFRE scientists also. Separate profile for each Scientist / Research Officer may be created on the web page of the institute. The details of the research papers published in National and International journal, papers presented in workshop/ seminars / research report and technical reports should feature therein.
