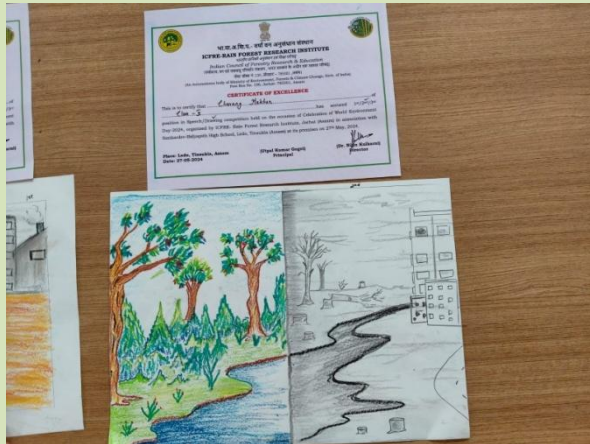

## 10-day celebrations by ICFRE-RFRI end
